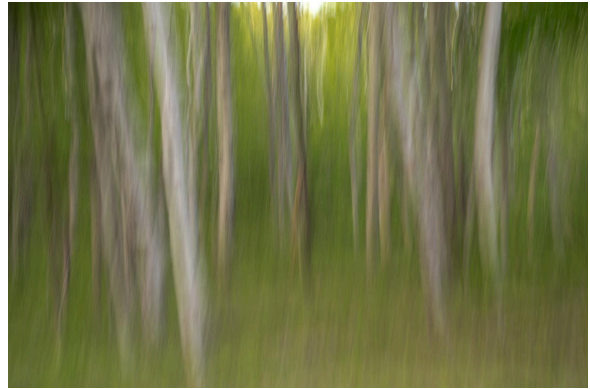
Photo Walk - ICM at Arnold Arboretum

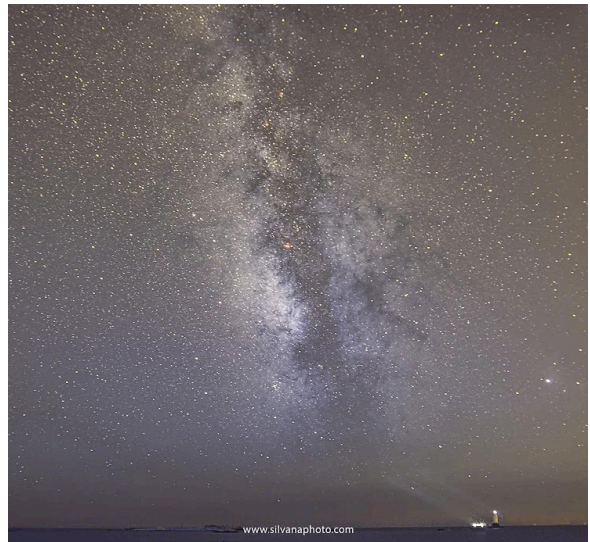


## X-Ray Vision at Night

## AI - The Good, the Bad & the Ugly

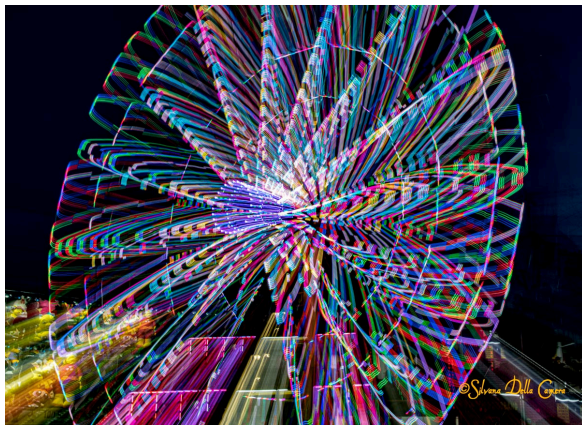
