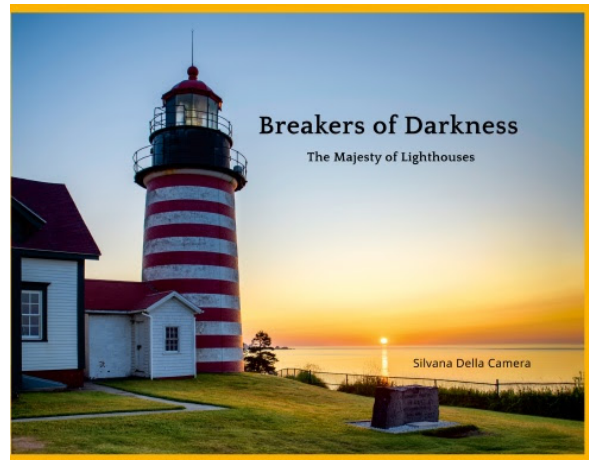

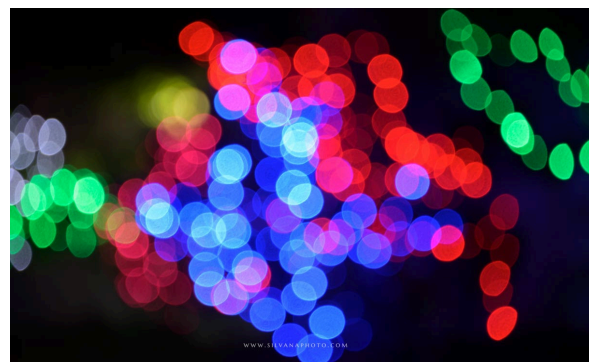

Gear Review - Variable Infrared Filter



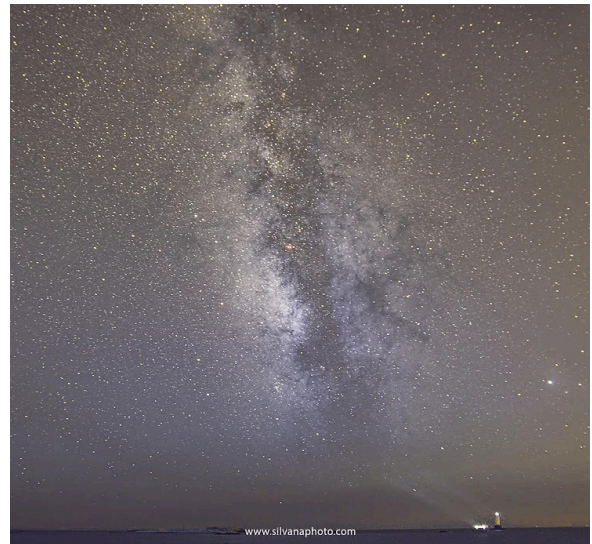
