The images didn't get a chance to upload to the cloud before I lost them all. I will be publishing a post soon about the cause of the debacle and the steps I'm taking to prevent something like this in the future. Luckily, I was able to recover the raw files from the CFExpress cards. Scary stuff. The image below is from Oregon. I had exported this small JPEG before I lost the folder.
